


Leading Roles



Kristen Meadows

(Think Shenae Grimes-Beech)

Practical, warm-hearted, and a little too used to carrying the weight of the world. Kristen helps run the family ranch and has been the backbone of The 12 Days of Ranchmas for years. She's organized, competitive, and secretly afraid of failure—especially after being burned by love once before. Beneath her composed exterior is someone who wants connection, but doesn't always know how to slow down long enough to let it in.



Wyatt Hawkins

(Think Kevin Mcgarry)

A rugged drifter with quiet charm and a mysterious edge. Wyatt's a former rodeo star who's walked away from fame and the spotlight, looking for something real. He's confident but humble, with a natural ease around animals and people alike. Beneath his stoic calm is a man craving belonging, and finding it in Kristen and her family may be the very thing that heals him.

The Meadows Family

Sam Meadows (50s)

Kristen's father and the heart of the ranch. Gruff yet good-humored, Sam's a lifelong cowboy who's seen both the hard years and the good ones. He supports Kristen but worries she's working herself too hard. Sam believes in the power of family and tradition, even if he doesn't always say it out loud.

Grace Meadows (50s)

The patient, steady matriarch who keeps the Meadows family grounded. Grace sees more than she lets on—especially the growing spark between Kristen and Wyatt. She gently reminds Kristen that love, like the ranch, requires a little faith and trust to flourish.

Grandma Rose (70s)

The spirited keeper of the ranch's legacy. Sharp-witted and full of heart, Grandma Rose refuses to let the family skip The 12 Days of Ranchmas—a tradition she started with her late husband. She's both comic relief and emotional anchor, reminding everyone what the season is really about: love, laughter, and legacy.

Lauren (mid-30s)

Kristen's older sister and confidante. A suburban mom with a chaotic family life, Lauren is equal parts supportive and snarky. She knows Kristen better than anyone and serves as her sounding board when things get messy with Wyatt. Lauren's humor and groundedness help balance the story's heart.

Ryan Meadows (20s)

Kristen's younger brother and wannabe influencer. He means well but often chooses content over contribution. His discovery of Wyatt's true identity becomes the story's turning point. Ryan provides comic energy but ultimately reminds everyone that family sticks together, even when things go viral.





Supporting Roles

Lauren's good-natured husband. He's the kind of guy who'd rather grill than gossip, often caught in the middle of Meadows family chaos. A few well-timed "dad jokes" keep the energy light when things get tense.

Lauren's kids and mini-agents of holiday chaos. Carson idolizes Wyatt, while Zoey playfully teases Kristen about her "cowboy crush." They help bring heart and humor to the family dynamics and make the ranch feel alive.

Kristen's competitive cousin and self-appointed queen of holiday glamour. She's bold, flirty, and not above stirring up a little drama—especially when she sets her sights on Wyatt. Her presence at the Holiday Hoedown reignites Kristen's insecurities, forcing her to face what (and who) she truly wants.

Wyatt's longtime manager, tough but loyal. A rodeo veteran who's seen it all, Randy's reputation and job are on the line when Wyatt vanishes before the national championship. Beneath his frustration is genuine concern; he's not just trying to save his career, but the cowboy he helped make a star.
